Chairman Nyblade called the telephonic meeting to order at a.m. In addition, a roll call was taken. Board members present at this time were Chairman Nyblade, Vice-Chairman Coleman, Secretary Mayes, Board Member Pettit, Board member Bright, Board member Searle, and Board member Brown.

## 3. Review, Discussion, and Approval of Minutes

Vice-Chairman Coleman moved to approve the minutes of the September 4, 2024, telephonic board meeting, open session.

Secretary Mayes seconded the motion, and unanimously, it carried.

# 4. <u>Agency Operations:</u>

Executive Director Megan Darian reported:

A. AZ Dispensing Opticians Licensee's renewal for 2024 started on October 1 for 905 active LDOs, of whom 371 have Continuing Education due this year.
Detailed instructions on renewing were sent to all the LDOs.
39 of them have already renewed their licenses.

6. Compliant against USV Optical - JC Penney Optical #1404, LOE-001427

Vice-Chairman Coleman, the liaison to the Board reported:

James McClafferty investigated JCPenney Optical #1404 at 10:30 AM on September 6, 2024. Both active establishment and LDO licenses were displayed at this location. He found patient records at this location unsecured and not filed or organized. Mr. McClafferty made a follow-up comparison visit to the JCPenney Optical located at the Superstition Mall in Mesa on September 14. He found the Superstition location to have patient records organized and properly filed. The majority of problems found at location #1404 appeared to be violations of HIPAA regulations and are not under the purview of this board. One potential rule violation could be a failure to maintain records under R4-20-118 since the records were not readily available because they were not filed or organized.

Vice-Chairman Susan Coleman after discussion and review of the case moved to dismiss complaint no. 2024-003, against USV Optical – JC Penny Optical #1404, Licensed Optical Establishment no. 001427 finding no violation of state statute or rule, but to refer the potential violations of HIPPA disclosure laws to the US Department of Health and Human Services civil rights division. Additionally, the Board moved to include the reference for failure to maintain records in the dismissal letter.

Secretary Mayes seconded the motion, and unanimously, it carried.
